What is the mission?

Starting date: September 8th, 2021

End date: June 8th, 2022

Duration: 9 months

Mission topics: Digital skills - Youth participation – Youthwork

Location: Rouen (1 volunteer)

The activities are:

- Filming and editing videos for informing young people on our YouTube channel (interviews, motion design, etc) and participating in the community management;
- Contributing to create different video formats with Canva (online software);
- Creating weekly stories and short chronicles on the Instagram account with the help of another volunteer;
- Taking part of the organisation of a local film festival entitled “Jeunes en Images” with a youth worker;
- Editing posters and banners for social media about the organisation’s events;
- Promoting the European Solidarity Corps program and encouraging young people to volunteer abroad;
- Helping the CRIJ Normandie team to realise its actions throughout the year.

Good to know

- You will work under the supervision of a youthworker
- You will work together with the team, in order to discover different youth information topics: employment, studies and trainings, civil and social rights, etc.
- You will have lots of space to implement your own activities in order to introduce your culture and language to the public.

Accommodation and costs

You will live in the city area of Rouen and have your own accommodation.

The room will be furnished and has access to a wi-fi connection.

There is also a public transport available.

You will get:

- a public transportation card;
- a french bank account;
- a free access to the Online Language Support platform.

According to the European Solidarity Corps program, the project covers all costs related to:

- Travel from your home country (back and forth),
- Accomodation,
- Food and pocket money (monthly allowance),
- Public transport,
- Health insurance (provided by Cigna insurance).
